

Asturias, located in the north of Spain, is a region with a rich history, stunning scenery and unique traditions that make it a popular tourist destination.

Since prehistoric times, Asturias has been an important region in the Iberian Peninsula. During Roman times, the region was known as Astures, and its people fought valiantly against the Roman invaders. With the passage of time, Asturias became a Christian region and joined León and Castilla to form the kingdom of León. In the 9th century, the kingdom of Asturias became the first Christian kingdom in Spain and heroically resisted the Muslim invasions.

The landscape of Asturias is one of its greatest tourist attractions. With its green mountains, white sandy beaches and rugged cliffs, the region is a paradise for nature lovers. One of the most impressive landscapes in Asturias is the Picos de Europa National Park, which is home to some of the highest mountains in Spain. It is also possible to enjoy nature on the coast of Asturias, where impressive beaches lay.

The traditions of Asturias are another important element of its culture. One of the best-known traditions is the culture of "sidra" (a local cider) that is lived throughout the region, and its gastronomy with its masterpiece the Asturian fabada, a plate of beans with sausages and meat.

Asturias is also rich in ethnographic and folkloric heritage, very diverse within the region itself, highlighting its winter masquerades that are little known internationally, its dance groups and traditional music bands, and many more ancestral traditions.

Being an Atlantic region, the weather is unpredictable, although in June the average temperature is 21°C during the day and 13°C at night, but in the mountains, they tend much lower and the probability of rain is one in three days.

For this reason, we recommend comfortable clothing, some of it waterproof, as well as comfortable shoes suitable for the rain.

There will be no black-tie events, so it is not necessary to bring formal clothing.
